## **RULES & REGULATIONS**

1. Entries must be received by 5pm Mon 15th March for the 27th March competition. By 5pm Mon 31<sup>st</sup> May for the 12th June competition, and by Mon 28th June for 10th July Competition. Draw will be available the Thursday before the competition.
2. Entries will close when classes are full. Classes may be balloted.
3. Horses must be registered for Official events.
4. You must be an EWA member to compete.
5. To be eligible to enter an Official competition the rider must be financial member of the EWA. The owner of the horse must be a financial member of the EWA. A rider may ride a pony in official competition from the start of the year they turn 10 years of age. A rider may ride a horse in official competition from the start of the year they turn 12 years of age. There is no maximum age for riding horses or ponies in official competition. Horse and Ponies must be EWA registered and have a Dressage Performance Card or Pony Dressage Performance Card. Ponies must hold a current, valid EWA height certificate showing they do not exceed 149cm with shoes, 148cm without shoes. A Bridle number must be worn.
6. Please note that program may be altered subject to the organisers discretion. Contact Jessica Blackwell 0407 850 033.
7. The Fee for tests is \$35 per test. Levies are \$7 for one test ridden, and \$12 if more then one test are ridden.
8. The Ground Service Fee for Brookleigh is \$10 per horse per day. This includes the use of yards. Yards are limited and will be taken on a first come, first served basis. If you wish to book a yard please contact Brookleigh on 9296 0018.
9. A \$10 helper fee will be charged per rider 1 per event payable on entry but will be reimbursed when/if your helper turns up to do their job. Any extra helpers supplied will also be reimbursed for their time and looked after well. Please contact Jessica on 0407 850 033 / equestricare@hotmail.com
10. Points are awarded to place getters in each class to the order of 1st - 6pts, 2nd - 5 pts, 3rd- 4pts, 4th - 3pts, 5th - 2pts, 6th - 1pt. If places are tied, both placegetters will be awarded the same number of points. The rider/horse combination with the most over the series will be the winner of the rug in each class. FEI rugs will be awarded to small tour and large tour.
11. If more then one combination gets the same number of points, the prize will be awarded to the combination with the highest collective marks.
12. Series is to be run over Saturday 27th March, Saturday June 12th and Saturday 10th July with rugs presented to the Overall Winners on Saturday 10th July
13. Trips to the Eastern States must be nominated for before the start of the first camp. You must compete in all three events to qualify. The trips will be awarded in EA classes and FEI classes. Trips will be awarded to the highest average score over all three camps.
14. The last camp will also be run as a Prix St George Challenge Qualifier.
15. The timing of the classes may change from the printed programme so please check the draw update when you arrive at the competition
16. Clothing and equipment as per EWA official dressage rules.
